As a Private Golf Club, the member who introduces you should provide you with all necessary information to make your visit to our Club a memorable one. Here are a few guidelines that will enable you to have a relaxing day at the Royal.

- Upon arrival, please present yourself to the Pro Shop personnel who will be pleased to assist you with further directions and any other assistance you require.
- The Royal maintains a dress code policy that is in keeping with the traditions of the game of golf. To review the complete dress code policy, please refer to the following page, or contact the Pro Shop at 819-777-0593 and they will be happy to answer any questions you may have.
- Please be reminded that the use of cellular telephones is forbidden in all areas of the Club-house, including all lounges, reception areas, verandah and patio, range and practice areas. (Men's and Women's locker rooms, and the parking lot are excepted.)
- We pride ourselves on our ability to maintain a normal pace of play of 2 hours per nine holes and a total of 4 hours for 18 holes.
- We hope you enjoy your day at the Royal.

After the game, we hope that you have an opportunity to enjoy our clubhouse facilities.



DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

The Royal maintains a dress code policy that is in keeping with the traditions of the game of golf.

Blue denim clothing is not permitted at any time in any of the dress categories.

Cargo style and spandex pants or shorts are not permitted at any time in any of the dress categories.

Guests should use discretion to ensure that any clothing logos are golf appropriate and discreet.

The Club's dress code standards are an important component of our Club's traditions. As a Club we are not pleased to have to guests to comply with our dress code; our goal is to ensure that all members and their guests enjoy their collective experience at our Club.

Golf Course

Men

Golf shirts with a collar or turtle neck tucked in, tailored golf shorts no higher than three inches above the knee cap and sockettes or knee length turn down socks are accepted. Demin of any style or color, cargo shorts and Golf Sandals are not permitted.

Ladies

Golf shirts with collars, turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks (sleeve or sleeveless) are acceptable. Golf shirts without collars must have sleeves. Sleeveless shirts must not be "cutaway" or halter style. Unless the style of shirt dictates otherwise, shirts must be tucked in at all times. Midriff-

baring shirts are not permitted. Full-length golf trousers or Capri style golf pants are permitted. Golf skirts, golf dresses and Bermuda style or tailored golf shorts of an appropriate length are acceptable. They may be no higher than five inches above the kneecap and not above mid-thigh. Knee length socks, sockettes or quarter socks are acceptable.

Clubhouse

After golf when you join your group in the Clubhouse or on the Verandah, all attire listed above as appropriate for the golf course is permitted. In addition, the following guidelines are applicable: socks are optional; women may wear sandals, but they are not permitted for men; and golf hats, caps and visors must be removed when inside the clubhouse **except when in transit to and from the locker rooms**. Other fashions appropriate to the occasion are also acceptable.

Wireless Communication Devices

When on Club property all wireless communication devices must be set to silent or vibrate mode.

The use of wireless devices for voice communication is forbidden in all areas of the Clubhouse, including all lounges, reception areas, verandah and patio, Pro Shop, range and practice areas. (Men's and women's locker rooms, telephone booths and the parking lot are excepted).

Wireless devices, including tablets, may be discreetly used for texting or email communication. Tablets may also be used for reading.

HOW TO FIND US

**1405 Aylmer Road
Gatineau, Quebec**

From the 417 Eastbound:

- Take Woodroffe exit, turn left towards ramp.
- Continue on Woodroffe
- Turn right on Ottawa River Parkway.
- Turn left on the Champlain Bridge
- 2nd set of lights (dead end / Aylmer Road), turn Right. NOTE: Merge left as the Club's driveway is immediately to your left.

From the 417 Westbound:

- Take Island Park exit.
- Continue on Island Park Drive, towards Ottawa River Parkway.
- Cross the Parkway onto Champlain Bridge
- 2nd set of lights (deadend / Aylmer Road), turn Right. NOTE: Take left-most lane, as club's driveway is immediately to your left.
